

THE WEBB SCHOOL SUMMER DAY CAMP 2020

In compliance with the Executive Orders of Tennessee and implementation of CDC guidelines, The Webb School Day Camp will adhere to the following procedures and protocols.

The following implementations are based on the best available information at the time. It is possible that the strategies and concepts outlined may change as understanding evolves regarding the unique challenges that COVID-19 poses. As such, the following should not be considered as rigid.

- The School Nurse will perform daily screenings of all campers and staff, including temperature monitoring upon arrival of all campers to the school. If your child will be riding the bus, please take your child's temperature at home, before he/she arrives at the bus stop. If your child has a temp of 99 degrees F or higher, please keep your child at home and monitor.
- Every participant will remain 6 feet apart throughout the duration of the day. Exception: First Aid and CPR emergencies.
- Limiting shared spaces and materials.
- Everyone will sanitize their hands (with provided hand sanitizer) upon entering or prior to exiting a room.
- Washing with soap and water for 20 seconds before snacks and lunch.
- All food will be prepackaged by our dining hall staff. Lunch will be held outside when weather permits and indoors, 6 feet apart, when there is inclement weather.
- Campers will need to bring a labeled water bottle each day. No one shall drink from the water fountains except to refill water bottles.
- Campers will be discouraged from any food/drink sharing or sharing of phones/tablets etc.
- We do not recommend that your child wear a mask during outside activities or inside physical activities. If you prefer that your child wear a mask, he/she may do so during inside/quiet activities, but the mask must be removed during physical exertion. Masks are not required for any campers.
- If you choose to wear gloves, they will need to be sanitized with hand sanitizer and soap and water just as frequently as if you were not wearing gloves.
- If a member of the community is experiencing fever, vomiting, fatigue or any other signs of illness, he/she will report to the School Nurse immediately for evaluation, and possible quarantine until this person can leave campus.
- We will still participate in our creek walk and slip 'n slide activities on Friday. "There is no current evidence that COVID-19 can be spread to people through the water in a pool or waterfront."
- There will be assigned seating for bus riders. Campers will sit one person to a seat and spread out with at least one row between them. All bags will be stored in the underneath compartments.
